**NOTE: HUMANITIES** - Regular revision sessions will take place throughout the year. Students will be notified of dates and venues as the courses progress.

The **Out-of-School-Hours Learning** programme is an extension of curriculum work, allowing students increased opportunities to further their studies and interests.

Activities are offered during lunch break and after school. The range of activities offered is largely governed by staff expertise and their availability. Many students take part in concerts and performances both in school and at local theatres. Sports fixtures are played against other schools. Transport is provided by school minibus or hired coach. Talented students are encouraged to attend County events to further increase their skills. A number of school trips are also organised throughout the year.

**For after school activities we advise students to ensure that parents are informed of their late arrival home and, if transport is required, that this has been arranged in advance.**

### STUDY CLUB

Study Club is offered after school on two evenings per week. **Students must register in the food court at 3.15pm and must not leave the school premises until study club ends.**

#### Transport for Study Club

Transport home is provided. Two buses will leave school at 4.45pm following the normal school bus routes.

#### Where will Study Club be held?

Study Club will be held in the School Library, Subject Learning Areas and the Study Area. A member of staff will be present to supervise and assist during each session.

#### When is Study Club?

The sessions will be run after school on a **Tuesday** and **Thursday** from **3.15 - 4.30pm**.

#### What will be offered?

Private Study; Research; Revision; Time Management; Independent Learning; Homework Study; Coursework Support; Teacher Support; Library Access; Computer Suite; Quiet Study; 'Chill Zone'.
