You will be aware of the announcement made earlier today by Kirsty Williams, Minister for Education in Wales that schools should now close for the Easter break on Friday 20th March 2020. This is clearly a significant move forward and the statement appears to indicate that this is designated as Easter holidays being brought forward but there are a number of matters referenced in the announcement that Directors of Education are seeking clarification on from Welsh Government this afternoon. Unfortunately school will remain closed for students in years 7-9 except for students whose parents/carers are NHS workers.
