Unit 2 – Year 11 Speaking Exam

- •April 2024
- •25% of the overall GCSE.
- Students are required to work in a pair or a group of three discussing an information sheet.
- Based on a topic from the GCSE course.
- Revision materials available on Google Classroom.

Unit 3 & 4 – Year 11 Exams

- •In summer 2024, Year 11 students will sit the unit 3 & 4 reading and writing examinations.
- •Unit 3 is worth 25% and Unit 4 is worth 25% of the overall GCSE.
- •Opportunities for students to practise the format of the exam questions in their Welsh lessons.
- There will also be revision materials including available on Google Classroom.

GCSE Physical Education

- The practical assessment = 50%
- It is important that students are observed at their best
- If performing/competing outside of school, they will need to be
- filmed for recorded evidence.
- Particularly important: skiing, horse-riding, mountain biking etc
- students need to be gathering this evidence now to support their
- practical assessment.
- The videos needs to be snippets of them competing, demonstrating
- specific skills and competitive elements.
- They should be clearly identified on the clips.























Attendance
