The course consists of 2 units for the single award:

Promoting Health and well-being (written examination)

- Definitions and concepts of health and well-being.
- Understanding perspectives of health, well-being and resilience.
- Supporting and promoting health, well-being and resilience in Wales.

Supporting health, well-being and resilience in Wales (internal assessment – 30 hours)

- Supporting individuals to achieve personal outcomes.
- Working practices within health and social care, and childcare provision.
- Local and national provision.
- Responsibilities and rights of both providers and individuals.

· A2 LEVEL – SINGLE AWARD

LEFEL A2 – GWOBR SENGL

The full A2 qualification consists of the AS units plus 2 further units from either the Childcare pathway or the Adult social care pathway.

Unit 3 Theoretical perspectives of children and young people's development.

Unit 4 Supporting the development, health, well-being and resilience of children and young people.

Unit 5 Theoretical perspectives of adult behaviour.

Unit 6 Supporting adults to maintain health, well-being and resilience.

Single award candidates will be assessed by one external written examination and one internally assessed piece of coursework.

- A2 LEVEL

Candidates will have completed their assessment for AS and the following are in addition to this: One external written examination and one internally assessed non-exam assessment.
